Changes include repaving the entire section of roadway, reconfiguring parking and cross walks, adding an 8-foot-wide multi-use pedestrian/bicycle path on both sides of the road and landscaping. Additional utility installations are also anticipated prior to the road repaving. While minimal land takings are proposed, there are several instances where items installed by abutting property owners that are located within the existing roadway right of way will need to be removed or relocated.
