2023 DOG LICENSE APPLICATION



It's Time to Get Your 2023 Dog License!

- **NEW!** The licensing period begins January 1, 2023 and ends **February 28, 2023**. All dogs must be licensed by February 28th or a \$50 late fee will be applied.
- All dogs 6 months and older living in the Town of Plainville must be licensed annually per Massachusetts General Law Chapter 140, Section 137.
- All dogs must have up-to-date rabies information on file. Dogs new to Plainville must also include a copy of spay/neuter if applicable.

How Do I Obtain a Dog License?

In Person: The Town Clerk's Office provides dog licenses during normal business hours Monday 8:00am-7:30pm and Tuesday-Thursday from 8:00am-4:30pm.

Online: Go to <https://epay.cityhallsystems.com>. Choose "Plainville" as the municipality and then choose "Dog License." You must upload a copy of your rabies certificate, and spay/neuter if applicable.

By Drop Box: Enclose completed application, self-addressed stamped envelope, and check made out to the Town of Plainville. Place in the secure drop box outside of town hall.

By Mail: Enclose completed application, self-addressed stamped envelope, and check made out to the Town of Plainville, and mail to Town Clerk, PO Box 1717, Plainville, MA 02762.

What Are the Fees?

Neutered Male/Spayed Female:	\$10	(add a \$50 late fee after February 28, 2023)
Intact Male/Female:	\$30	(add a \$50 late fee after February 28, 2023)



- Residents 70 or older at the time of licensing qualify for a free dog license.
- Ownership of four dogs or more requires a multiple pet permit or kennel license. Please contact the Town Clerk's Office.
- If you no longer have your dog or no longer live in Plainville, please contact us at 508-695-3010 ext. 1 so we may update our records.

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It is the owner's responsibility to license their dog(s) **no later than February 28, 2023**. Owners must provide (enclose) proof of up-to-date rabies and spay/neuter if applicable. Please remember to enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for all mail & drop box order dog licenses.
